The information given to International Students will be reviewed annually before the December meeting of the Board of Trustees to ensure it is accurate and relevant.

The Review will be done by way of the Principal's Report to the Board of Trustees.

Approving changes highlighted in the Review will be done by the Board. These changes will be implemented by the Principal.

The Ministry of Education Review will be completed by the Principal.

GUIDELINES

- Fees will be set annually by the Board of Trustees
- Fees are to be paid in advance on an annual or Term by Term basis at the discretion of the Principal.



Fees Refund Conditions for International Students

• An application for refund of fees must be made in writing by the parent/caregiver to the Board of Trustees of HIS explaining why the student has been withdrawn from the course and the reasons for seeking a refund.

If the application is made before the start of the course, the fees will be refunded in full less an administration charge to cover costs incurred by the school of \$500.00.

• If the application is made after the start of the course, the fees will be refunded less:

- An administration charge
- Costs to the school already incurred for tuition
- Components of the fee already committed for the duration of the course, including appropriate proportions of salaries of teachers and support staff (if applicable)
- Costs already incurred for the use of facilities and resources
- The proportion of the Government Levy the school is required to pay
- Any other costs already incurred.
- No refund will be made if the student decides to change school.
- No refund will be made if the enrolment is terminated by the school due to poor attendance or inappropriate behaviour.
- All other situations will be assessed on their merits and a partial refund may be made.
- No refund will be made to a student whose parents acquire permanent residency during the student's tuition contract unless this has been negotiated and put in writing prior to enrolment.

Fees Protection

- All International Students will be required to take insurance which protects the payment of fees.
- In the event of a refund becoming necessary, the school will hold sufficient funds in a designated a budget and these funds are not spent in advance.

ACCOMMODATION FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

Henderson Intermediate School is fully compliant with the Code of Practice. The school is responsible for homestay accommodation.

GUIDELINES

1. Homestay Accommodation

Parents will need to sign the indemnity agreement if a student is staying in a homestay situation with either a


caregiver or relative. HIS will still visit a designated caregiver. Homestay accommodation will be visited by the school as per Ministry requirements. Police Vet will be obtained by the school for all homestay caregivers who are not members of the International Students family.

The Principal's PA will meet with homestay students to ensure that their accommodation is suitable as per Ministry requirements.
